COURSE INFORMATION:

Location: Monona Terrace, Madison, WI

Cost: \$695.00 for three credits (less \$25 for each person you recruit to take the class along with you plus \$25 for each recruit!) plus WSCA conference costs and possibly preconference costs, depending on your choice of onsite time. You can choose to take the course in one or two sections.

Dates and Times: The course timeline involves two onsite days plus follow-up online or by mail. The onsite meeting dates are either Feb. 17-18 (Section 1) or Feb. 18-19 2015 (Section 2). The timelines are listed below. The course completion date for both sections is March 6, 2015.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

In the distant past there have been one, two and three-credit choices. The 2015 course is three graduate credits. Following is an overview of the timeline possibilities.

*Begin Tuesday morning at 8:30 am; participate in the full day pre-conference and Wednesday conference. Complete the onsite responsibilities by 6:00pm Wednesday. Register for section (1) of the course.

*Begin Tuesday at Noon; participate in the half-day pre-conference and additional evening requirements plus the Wednesday conference. Complete the onsite responsibilities by 6:00 pm Wednesday. Register for the section (1) of the course.

*Begin Wednesday morning at 7:30 am; participate in the full conference and complete the onsite responsibilities by 3:30 pm on Thursday. Register for the section (2) of the course.
