Type of Data	How Data are Collected	Examples
<p>Process Data</p>	<p>Keep track of number of participants, number of sessions in a log</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Number of students attending an event. ● Number Junior Conferences provided ● Number of lessons/small group meetings provided ● Number of students who filled out a FAFSA ● Number of students who completed a college application
<p>Perception Data</p>	<p>Data collected using surveys, pre/post tests, program evals, needs assessments or opinion surveys.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pre/Post tests given before/after junior conferences ● Pre/Post tests given before/after small group counseling or a lesson/seminar/activity ● Assessing students attitudes, knowledge or skills
<p>Outcome Data</p>	<p>Reports from the student information system are analyzed (grades, attendance, discipline reports, state testing results, enrollment reports)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Graduation rates from year to year ● Attendance data for identified students from one quarter to another ● GPA for identified students from before/after intervention ● AP Course enrollment from year to year
