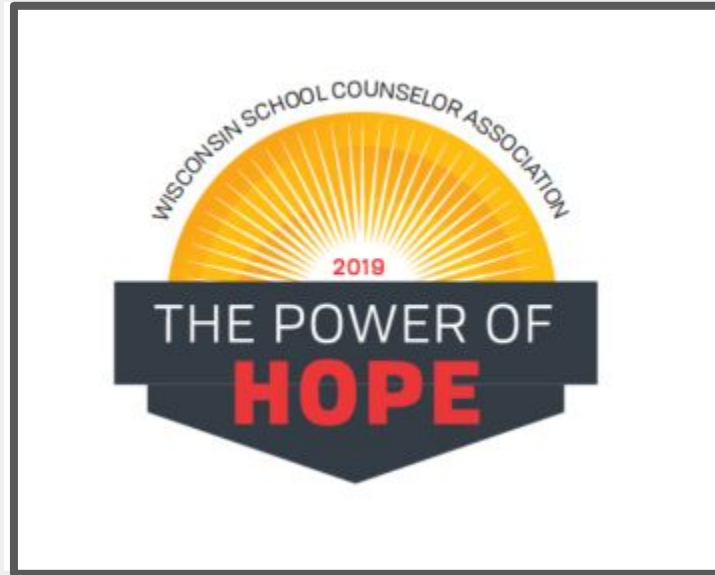

SURVEY

Significant Changes for Online YRBS for this year:

- New online platform! (Using only *Qualtrics*)
- New process! Implemented to streamline process and improve data.
 - Standardized timeframe for survey - spring semester, odd years
 - **For 2018-19 only:** Spring survey window is January - March
- Standardized questionnaires with standard block and 4 optional modules that can be added for more in-depth data:
 - Drug free core measures
 - Tobacco
 - Adversity, protective factors, and mental health
 - Safe & supportive schools
- Questions from all 4 of those areas are included in standardized block



Application process for the FY 2019-2021 School-based Mental Health Services (SMHS) Grants is now open!

- All public school districts, independent charter schools or a consortium of the two can apply.
- If you are a current recipient of the SMHS grant you are eligible to apply again.

FAFSA Student Level Data

- NEW data sharing agreement between HEAB and DPI
- School districts will be able to opt in with signed agreement sent to me
- Requires designation of new data user security level - will be a dashboard in WISEdash for districts under “Postsecondary” topic area
 - Available Spring 2019!
- The summary dashboard displays a bar graph for all 12th grade students and categorizes them into FAFSA filing status:
 - Not Started - No FAFSA application has been received by the US ED
 - In Process - A FAFSA application has been started but not finished
 - Completed - A FAFSA application is complete
- Data upload will be done more often during peak completion months - refreshed in WISEdash 2-3 x/week
