- PreK-5th grade
- 18.1% Students with disabilities
- 15% Economically Disadvantaged
- 2.2% ELL
- 91% white
- 3.1% Hispanic/Latino
- 2.5% Black or African American
- 1.6% Asian
- 1.9% Two or more races

Houlton

- 220 Students
- K- 5th grade
- 16% Students with disabilities
- 12% Economically Disadvantaged
- 0% ELL
- 95% white
- 1.8%Hispanic/Latino
- .5 Black or African American
- 0% Asian
- 2.7% Two or more races


- Empowered students

- Students doing body breaks or using tools to self-regulate





Legend of Rock Paper Scissors







Connections to Climate


- Students provided tools and space to self-regulate = more time in the classroom & positive connection to school

- SEL skills




- Teaching students the zones

Calming/Refocusing Corner at Willow River









 Schedule shift = Kinder schedule built in prescribed time


