Session A: Data Boot Camp - Beginner: Using Data in your school counseling program/WSCPAR Introduction

Learn how completing a Wisconsin School Counseling Program Accountability Report (WSCPAR) can help with writing SLOs, SPO's, PPG's, promoting your program, and utilizing data to show how your program is impacting students. You will walk step by step through the data process and you will learn what makes an impactful graph, how to write SMART Goals (which can lead to SLOs), and more. You'll learn tips and suggestions to approach the process and how to submit your WSCPAR application.

Session B: Data Boot Camp - Advanced: RAMP Camp/WSCPAR Ready

Bring your process, perception and outcome data and comprehensive counseling program components to this session to take your school counseling program to the next level! Learn more about RAMP and the Wisconsin School Counselor Accountability Report (WSCPAR)! Based on the ASCA National Model, RAMP is a recognition program for individual schools, not districts or school counselors. Applying for RAMP helps schools evaluate their school counseling program, discover areas for improvement and enhance the program's efforts to contribute to student success. The RAMP application process should be the culmination of the implementation of a comprehensive school counseling program, which typically takes three-five years to implement. Once a school has a program in place, it will need at least one entire academic year to collect the data and information needed to fulfill the RAMP and WSCPAR application requirements. Your trainer will guide you through the application requirements and process.

Session C: Solution-Focused Counseling – Covering the Bases and Applying the Lessons in ONE DAY!

The focus of this presentation is to assist those familiar with Solution Focused Counseling and are interested in brushing up on their training, going beyond the miracle question with their clients. The presentation will include a brief review of vital foundational skills that allow counselors to listen so they can really hear. Then explore Solution-Focused counseling foundations and applications to talk so others will listen. We will engage in SFC skill practice together, sharing feedback using solution-focused supervision techniques and exploring your client questions and concerns as you expand your knowledge and experience.
